

Now Hiring- Child and Family Advocate (FT)

Adams County Children's Advocacy Center seeks a Child and Family Advocate (FT). In this position, you will provide a wide variety of direct services to support, coordinate and provide for consistent and comprehensive services for children suspected of having been abused or neglected and their non-offending caregivers. Additional responsibilities include supporting the general day-to-day activities of the Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) as well as promoting and advocating for the programs offered through the CAC, including conducting outreach and education efforts to the community on the prevention of child abuse.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Assist victims and their families with a wide range of supportive and advocacy services including crisis assessment and intervention, risk assessment and safety planning.
- Assess victim and non-offending caregiver's needs and cultural considerations for information and community referrals for counseling, financial aid, housing, protective orders, domestic violence intervention, food, transportation, public assistance, etc.
- Provide education and access to victims' rights and crime victim's compensation.
- Inform and support the child and family throughout the coordinated multidisciplinary response.
- Actively participate in ACCAC community outreach efforts, prevention education and agency functions.
- Coordinate/participate in monthly Multidisciplinary Case Review activities

Education & Experience:

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Criminal Justice or related field or Associate's degree in Human Services or related field, plus a minimum of two years of experience in the human services field with knowledge, experience and expertise in issues related to child abuse and/or victims of crime and family violence.
- Skills in communicating/networking between agencies and professionals.
- Good organizational and writing skills.
- Training and/or experience in victim advocacy preferred. Must be willing to travel for required Victim Advocacy and Support training (per NCA Standards).
- Bilingual (Spanish) a plus.
- Must maintain all appropriate/required clearances.
