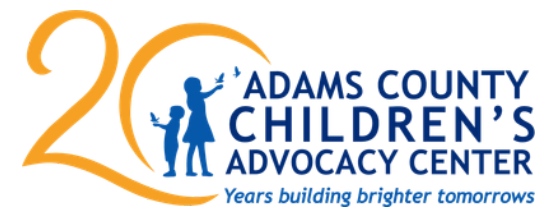

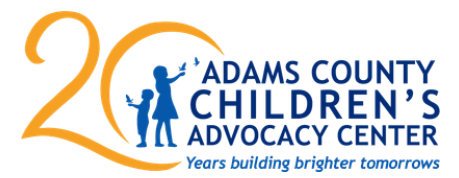

ABOUT THE CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

In 1982, Congress declared June 6-12 the first Child Abuse Prevention Week. The following year, April was designated the official National Child Abuse Prevention Month. The theme of blue was started in 1989 by a grandmother who lost her grandson to child abuse. Blue continues to be used to this day, across the nation, in honor of child abuse victims.

Adams County Children's Advocacy Center recognizes Child Abuse Prevention Month through our annual "Go Blue" campaign, raising awareness throughout the community.
